New NMFC for Power Pumps

The National Motor Freight Traffic Association is amending its National Motor Freight Classification (NMFC) for power pumps. The changes take effect April 27.

Item 128000 now assigns freight classes based on packaging and density. Also, the reference to "Power Pump Parts, NOI" is being removed.

Updated NMFC Item 128000

The following descriptions become effective April 27:

Item 128000 MACHINERY GROUP: subject to Item 114000
Pumps, power, NOI:

- Sub 1 In boxes or crates, subject to Item 170 and having a density in pounds per cubic foot of:
- Sub 2 Less than 8 = **Class 175**
- Sub 3 8 but less than 15 = **Class 92.5**
- Sub 4 15 or greater = **Class 65**

- Sub 5 In packages other than boxes or crates, subject to Item 170 and having a density in pounds per cubic foot of:
- Sub 6 Less than 8 = **Class 200**
- Sub 7 8 but less than 15 = **Class 100**
- Sub 8 15 or greater = **Class 70**
